




### Guidance for chair with four legs or castors

1. Locate a link arm over each raising unit (2), making sure the lip faces up on one and down on the other as shown in (3) below
2. Set out as shown in (1) below, with loose wing nuts
3. Place linked raisers on the floor, as close as possible to each leg or castor
4. Adjust arm angles as required
5. Place furniture on raising units. Tip furniture whenever possible, forwards first, rather than lifting. Repeat by tipping backwards to fit front raisers.
6. Pull link arms together, allowing space for the users feet. Spreader bar should run "arm to arm", to avoid a hazard at front of chair.
7. Tighten the wing nuts to secure.
8. Ensure chair is stable on the raisers before use. Product to be used in static mode only.


